Fifth and Columbia tower construction to start in fall: Report

The construction of a new 660-foot-tall tower at the corner of Fifth and Columbia streets in downtown Seattle will begin this fall, according to a report.

<u>The Seattle Times reports</u> developers Daniels Development of Seattle and equity partner Stockbridge Capital Partners of San Francisco said they'll begin construction later this year of Seattle's tallest building to be built in the last two decades, with the \$400 million project expected to be finished in mid-2016.
